Suzanne Kelly, Ph.D. is a scholar, farmer and writer, whose most recent book, *Greening Death—Reclaiming Burial Practices and Restoring Our Tie to the Earth* (Rowman & Littlefield, 2015), traces the philosophical and practical underpinnings of the burgeoning green burial movement in the U.S. A fellow green burial advocate, she chaired the committee to form the 2nd municipally operated green burial ground in New York State which opened in 2014. The following year she was the recipient of the Green Burial Council's Leadership Award, recognized for her "demonstrated foresight, innovation, and extraordinary commitment to the environment through sustainability and attainability in the area of human death care practices." She writes and farms in Rhinebeck, NY, where she also currently serves as the administrator of the town's cemetery.
