1. Biographical Information about Gordon Laxer

Gordon Laxer is a political economist, professor emeritus at the University of Alberta, and the founding Director of Parkland Institute. He is the author of two award-winning books, *After the Sands: Energy and Ecological Security for Canadians* and *Open for Business: The Roots of Foreign Ownership in Canada*, and the editor of several books. He has published over 40 journal articles and refereed book chapters and reports.

He was Principal Investigator of a \$1.9 million, four-country research project, *Neoliberal Globalism and its Challengers: Reclaiming the Commons in the Semi-periphery*.

His op-eds have been published in *The Toronto Star*, *The Globe and Mail*, *The Edmonton Journal*, *The Vancouver Sun*, *The Calgary Herald*, *The Montreal Gazette*, *El Universal* (Mexico), and other publications. He has also been a regular guest on current affairs radio and television programs, including the CBC's *The Current*, *As It Happens*, and *Face Off*.
