### **Background on Ted Spence and Bruce McClennan**

#### **1. Ted Spence Bio**

Ted Spence has been a member of the Executive Committee since soon after the establishment of the CEWF and is a member of the boards of the Cavendish Community Ratepayers Association and of the Catchacoma Cottagers Association. He and his wife Susan are longtime cottagers on Catchacoma Lake which is part of the Mississauga Lake chain, the largest single reservoir on the TSW. They also have family members with lake front property on Little Bob Lake.

Ted recently completed seven years as a member of the board of the Federation of Ontario Cottagers' Associations (FOCA) including two years as president. In that role, he maintained active liaison between CEWF and FOCA. Ted retired in 2009 as Professor Emeritus after a 39-year career at York University, which included a 10-year term as Dean of the Faculty of Environmental Studies and 10 years as Senior Policy Advisor to the University President. His academic focus was environmental planning and hydrology.

#### **2, Bruce McClennan Bio**

Bruce McClennan owns property on Gull Lake and is a member of the Gull Lake Cottagers' Association. He joined the CEWF and the Executive Committee in 2010. Bruce is a water resources engineer who worked for Acres International on assignments worldwide for over 30 years in water resource planning and hydroelectric development. Bruce and his wife Carol cottaged on Boshkung Lake for a number of years and then bought Ogopogo Resort on Mountain Lake in 2002, sold it in 2007, and now live year-round at their home on Gull Lake.
